Brno Zoo is located on the western outskirts of the city, in the urban district Bystrc, near Brno Reservoir. Its exhibitions are located in a pleasant natural environment on 25 hectares of wooded hillsides of Monk's Hill (Mniší hora). The youngest visitors are well taken care of. At the Children's Zoo, they can pet sheep and goats, peer into rabbit holes or ride a pony. There are also climbing frames, slides and many other attractions.

Brno Underground - Labyrinth Under the Vegetable Market

Labyrinth (Zelný trh 21)

As a part of the tourist route, visitors will see unique and mysterious corners of mediaeval corridors and cellars hidden six to eight metres under ground. They will learn how food, wine and beer were preserved in the past and what illuminated the underground space. The exhibition also includes a collection of archeological findings. Part of the tour is an alchemist's laboratory commemorating famous doctors, pharmacists and physicists who worked in Brno and made the city popular throughout Europe. The shady sides of life in ancient times are told by replicas of the city pillory and the madman's cages that stood in the marketplace in the 17th century.



How can we visit the Labyrinth?

It is not wheelchair accessible due to stairs.

Brno Underground - Ossuary at st.Jacob

Ossuary (Jacob's Square/Jakubské náměstí)

The second biggest ossuary in Europe. The number of buried people here is estimated at more than fifty thousand. The cemetery at the Church of St. Jacob on today's Jacob's Square existed as early as the beginning of the 13th century. Just like other city cemeteries, it was founded inside the walls which prevented its later expansion. The capacity was soon no longer sufficient for the needs of the growing city and a system of interchangeable burials had to be introduced: ten to twelve years after the burial, the grave was opened, the remains were removed and another deceased was placed there



How to visit the Ossuary?

It is not wheelchair accessible due to stairs.

Tours are every half an hour (9:30, 10:00, 10:30...to 17:30)

Old Town Hall Tower

Nowadays, the Old Town Hall serves mainly for cultural purposes. In its premises, there is a gallery, an information centre and a permanent exhibition about the history of this building. In the summer season, you can visit the Crystal Hall, the Fresco Hall and the Treasury or climb the 63 metre high tower which gives you an impressive view of Brno

Exhibition Treasures of the Špilberk Bandit

Špilberk, as a medieval castle and later a Baroque fortress, always hosted a military garrison within its walls, whether during the Middle Ages, during the siege of Brno by the Swedes, or during the Second World War, when the German Wehrmacht troops were stationed there.

Visitors to the castle have a unique opportunity to see it, What has been hidden from the public eye until now, such as weapons and armour of the Middle Ages, the story of Brno's armed bourgeois and rifle corps or rare and decorative weapons, along with a reminder of the work of Brno's gunsmiths.

Indoor attractions

Autodrome, slide, boats, trampolines or bouncy attractions such as BruNo's pillow but also unconventional entertainment - Hamster wheel, labyrinth (Chacha box) or air hockey and table football.

Outdoor attractions

Water World where you can find Archimedes screws, pumps, sluices, water wheels of all types or even a pond. Children and adults can jump from a two or four metre Bagjump, ride on pedal cars, take a ride on a unique carousel (for up to thirty children), jump on trampolines or on an inflatable pillow or enjoy a ride on a water slide where you can get through a mole hole or a stork's nest.
