

2/ Guided walking tour of the city of Brno



What awaits you?

 A professional guide will take you to the most interesting sights of old Brno and make you familiar with the history of the city of Brno and some important buildings. You will see the Old Town Hall (Stará radnice), the Baroque fountain Parnassus (Parnas) at the Cabbage Market (Zelný trh), the Dietriechstein Palace (Dietrichsteinský palác), the Church of the Holy Cross (kostel Nalezení svatého Kříže), the Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul (katedrála sv. Petra a Pavla, (including the interior). At the Liberty Square (Náměstí Svobody), you will see, among other things, the "famous" clock machine and the plague column and statues of 4 Plato 's virtues on the Moravian Square (Moravské náměstí). If the current situation allows, you will also visit the Brno underground!

3 / Handbike races on the pumptrack circuit and skill League triathlon

During the ride, the participant in the wheelchair must use a wooden sword to catch the straw wreaths hanging above his head. Each participant has one attempt. It will be possible to rent a mechanical wheelchair.

• Fish catching on the eyelets with a hook

Fishing on a fishing rod. Each participant must catch as many small fish with an eye on the fishing rod within 1 minute as possible. The number of small fish is 15.

Moravian museums

Bishop's Courtyard (Biskupský dvůr) – history of the Moravian flora and fauna

What awaits you?

 This diverse set of buildings, surrounded on three sides by a landscaped courtyard, is located in the historic part of Brno, under the cathedral church of St. Peter and Paul. The originally gothic building of the rectory of the Brno Chapter was bought in 1588 by the Bishop of Olomouc



Stanislav Pavlovský (hence the "Bishop's Court") and thoroughly rebuilt for the new owner by the Italian architect Antonio Gabri. The alterations after 1600 were completed by Cardinal František Dietrichstein, the successor of Bishop Pavlovsky. A prismatic tower and a building with partially exposed grey brickwork and narrow angled and rectangular windows have been preserved from the oldest construction phase. In late gothic style is built the chapel on the second floor of the tower with the life of saints scenes. For the Renaissance phase, there is an eloquent arcade and a one-storey arcaded loggia. The permanent exhibition includes the exhibitions Fauna of Moravia and the Aquarium of Freshwater Fish.

Dietriechstein palace (Dietrichsteinský palác) – history of Moravia

What awaits you?

The Dietrichstein Palace on the Cabbage • Market (Zelný trh) in Brno occupies an place in the important baroque architecture of Moravia. It was built in 1614-1618 bv Cardinal František Dietrichstein, Bishop of Olomouc, as one of the family residences. The assumption that the Italian architect Giovanni Giacomo Tencalla made plans for the construction is considered unlikely today.



The entrance portal and vestibule recall the thorough reconstruction of the palace before 1748. Among the exhibitions, you will find the period of prehistory, the Middle Age, the world of minerals, traditional folk culture and more.

Mendel museum – the life and work of G. J. Mendel

What awaits you?

 Want to know the place where genetics was born more than 150 years ago? Visit the Mendel Museum of the Masaryk University. At this place, as part of three sightseeing tours and exhibitions, you will meet Gregor Johann Mendel as the father of genetics, the abbot of



the Augustinian order, a meteorologist and a passionate beekeeper.

Old Town Hall (with access to the Town Hall Tower)

What awaits you?

 Today, the Old Town Hall is used mainly for cultural purposes. In its premises, there is a gallery, the information centre and a permanent exhibition on the history of this building. In the summer season, you can visit the Crystal Hall, the Fresco Hall and the Jewel Hall or climb the 63-meter high tower, which promises an impressive view of Brno. Concerts, festivals, theatre performances and film screenings take place in the courtyard.



The arched passage between Radnická Street and the courtyard forms a richly decorated portal with the legendary bent turret, created in 1511 by the sculptor and carver Anton Pilgram, a representative of late Gothic. There are two reminders of well-known legends in the passage - a bow wheel and a crocodile or the Brno dragon. The courtyard with Renaissance arcades from the end of the 16th century is the work of Italian builders; other modifications are the result of early Baroque reconstruction. The Old Town Hall served its purpose until 1935, after which the authorities moved to the premises of the New Town Hall on Dominican square.

 Dušan Jurkovič's own villa in Brno's district Žabovřesky from 1906 is one of the finest examples of modernist architecture inspired by British and Viennese art with elements of folk art. Visitors can enjoy the



extraordinary atmosphere of the house and its garden. The central staircase hall has been restored to an almost authentic appearance; the reception hall is furnished with Jurkovič's original furniture from the Molitorov chateau. The exhibition also presents the work of Dušan Jurkovič in the Czech Republic and Slovakia.

Anthropos Pavilion - history of Moravia

What awaits you?

 The permanent exhibition of the Anthropos Pavilion about the oldest history of settlement in Moravia and the entire European continent consists of 3 basic units, in the creation of which our leading scientific experts participated: "Moravia of hunters and gatherers", "The oldest art of



Europe" and "Paleolithic technologies". In the second part, the viewer will find current knowledge from the research of human evolution and the beginnings of its culture: "Genetics in human development" and "The story of the human race", supplemented by introducing the behaviour and life of human closest creatures primates, presented in the section "Primates, our family." The newly built exhibition will offer not only current knowledge from research in archaeology, anthropology, genetics, etc., but also brings interactive presentations thanks to modern audiovisual technology and is enriched by a number of dioramas and reconstructions of the environment and life of Paleolithic hunters and gatherers. Of course, visitors will not miss the famous reconstruction of the mammoth, which is now also surrounded by natural surroundings. A guided tour of the Anthropos Pavilion exhibits will introduce you to the oldest history of humankind, the origin and development of man and the beginnings of art and culture.



Fireworks start: 22.30

Music for fireworks is traditionally broadcasted on FM radio station. The original musical accompaniment synchronized with fireworks will be broadcasted exclusively for all fireworks by Radio Krokodýl 103 FM. All you have to do is find a place with a view of Špilberk, in accordance with the current epidemiological rules, and tune in to the fireworks on the FM radio. Online broadcasts of fireworks are being prepared. A new feature will be fireworks "live" broadcasts in high definition. Not only the YouTube channels BRNOmycity and South Moravia are being considered for broadcasting, but live streaming of fireworks on the official channel of the Czech Republic "Visit the Czech Republic" is also under discussion as part of the support of the state agency CzechTourism for the IGNIS BRUNENSIS festival.
